## OSBORNE MINE DEVELOPMENT AND PRODUCTION



### SCOPE

- Develop the Kulthor orebody down to its economic basement whilst completing remnant mining at the previously completed Osborne orebody
- Conduct long-hole open stoping in Kulthor and Osborne orebodies
- Maintenance of client mobile equipment.

### KEY PROJECT OUTCOMES

- All development requirements advanced to completion
- 4.2 million tkms of ore moved over the first 17 months of the contract
- Shared management of work force with client personnel to minimise costs.
